"I was being chased by two men around corners and down corridors at full speed. It was very tricky because you had

to run fast, and I just slipped going around a corner," he told me.

Luckily for Redman, who was in Saving Private Ryan, Schindler's List, Lovejoy and The Knock, his injuries were not serious and he managed to carry on as a Romanian terrorist intent on blowing up the British Prime Minister.

Having lived in Russia before settling in London eight years ago, he found the Romanian accent not too difficult. "You just put on a stronger accent and roll your Rs a lot."
